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# What is a World Café ?

#### The World Café is:



A real **focus on listening** and to go deeper and faster into the individuals' thinking



A great way to **reflect on the patterns, themes and deeper questions** within small groups and to **share them** within a larger group




A tool to consolidate lots of ideas



# Why World Café ?

The World Café outcome may be:

- A higher intensity of communication between the working groups
- A common understanding of what we would like to achieve within StanDerm
- A strategic approach of how to address
  the outside world
- A maximum of internal and external benefit of StanDerm





# How does it work ?

- Small groups will stand at tables and will discuss a question
- A host will guide the discussion
- The **host will remain** at the same table for the whole time
- Guests will move on individually (not as a group!) to another table after 20 minutes to discuss a new question
- The results of the previous discussion at the table will be used to start the discussion of the next question by the new guests, adding their thoughts and ideas and link them
- Scribble and paint on the tablecloth



### Summary
