What is a World Café ?

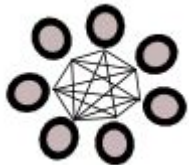
The World Café is:



A real **focus on listening** and to go deeper and faster into the individuals' thinking



A great way to **reflect on the patterns, themes and deeper questions** within small groups and to **share them** within a larger group

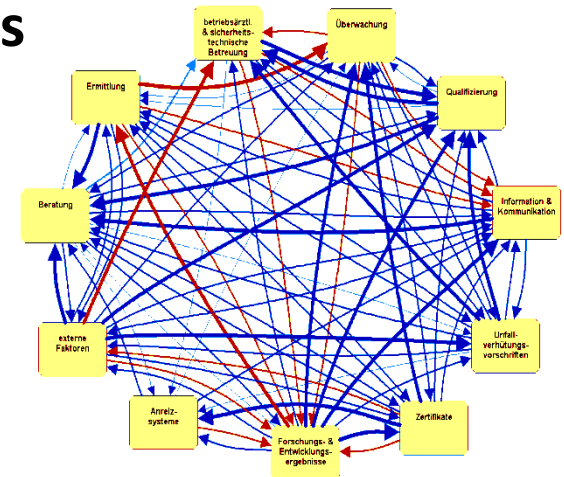


A tool to **consolidate lots of ideas**

Why World Café ?

The World Café outcome may be:

- A higher intensity of **communication between the working groups**
- A **common understanding** of what we would like to achieve within StanDerm
- A strategic approach of **how to address the outside world**
- A maximum of **internal and external benefit** of StanDerm



How does it work ?

- Small groups will stand at tables and will discuss a question
- A **host** will guide the discussion
- The **host will remain** at the same table for the whole time
- **Guests will move on individually** (not as a group!) to another table **after 20 minutes to discuss a new question**
- The **results of the previous discussion** at the table will be used to start the discussion of the next question by the new guests, adding their thoughts and ideas and link them
- **Scribble and paint** on the tablecloth

Summary

- **3 different questions -> 1 question per round**
- **3 rounds** of discussion (20 minutes each)
- Join a table and then **move individually to another table**. Please take care for a **good mixture between the working groups** (colored dots on name tags)
- **Color code of questions** provides orientation when switching tables (**Q1=blue, Q2=green, Q3=red**)
- **Please use the pencil with the appropriate color** for your scribbling
- **Host stays** at the same table and continuously guides the discussion
